Take MD-166 Rolling Road Exit toward Catonsville, 0.1 mile. Turn slight right onto S. Rolling Road / MD-166, 2 miles. Turn right onto Frederick Road / MD-144, 0.06 miles. Church is on the left.

From **WEST / FREDERICK** - Take I-70 East toward Baltimore, 37 miles. Merge onto I-695 S via Exit 91 B-A toward I-95 South / Baltimore / Glen Burnie, 3 miles. Take MD-144 / Frederick Road, Exit 13 towards Catonsville, 0.1 mile. Turn right onto Frederick Road / MD-144, 1 mile. Church is on the right.

On Sunday, February 8 at around 1:15 p.m. I was entering the parking lot of the Cathedral arriving early to prepare for my 2:00 p.m. recital. As I am parking my car I see Gordon Biscomb's car, our official photographer for the Hilbus Chapter in the parking lot. I immediately go over to Gordon's car and thank him for traveling the 200+ mile trip from Aberdeen, MD to Altoona, PA. Gordon's replied that he did not want to miss my recital that I had prepared for my 60th birthday and to see and hear the 1931 Steinmeyer Pipe Organ, the only one in the United States. Gordon's asked if he could take photos of me at the organ console plus photos of the second largest cathedral in Pennsylvania.
